Mr. Ingersol was the founding CEO of the Hostcentric consolidation, and has served on its Board of Directors since inception. Hostcentric recently agreed to be acquired for \$25.8 million by Interland, a publicly held web hosting company.

Prior to starting the Hostcentric project, Mr. Ingersol practiced in the Corporate Finance and Mergers & Acquisitions groups of the law firms of Morrison & Foerster, Sonnenschein Nath & Rosenthal, and Jackson Tufts Cole & Black where he advised companies and investors in connection with mergers, acquisitions, investments and securities law issues.

Mr. Ingersol's work has included advising OneComm Corporation in its acquisition by Nextel, National Semiconductor in its acquisition of Comlinear Corporation, Rockpile Interactive in its acquisition by Snyder Communications, Swan Magnetics in its acquisition of SVI, Inc., Beyond.com in its divestiture of CyberSource Corporation, and LAM Research in its \$310 million Convertible Notes offering and the subsequent listing of the Notes on the Luxembourg Stock Exchange.

Mr. Ingersol also served as Director of Strategic Development and Counsel for Xing Technology Corporation, an audio and video streaming technology company. In these capacities, he helped Xing secure venture capital financing, close a number of strategic partnerships, and align the company for a \$75 million acquisition by RealNetworks.

Mr. Ingersol serves on the Board of Directors of Back on Track, a non-profit, which supports the tutoring of over 200 San Francisco inner city students
